

J. E. EDMONDSON SCHOLARSHIP

A scholarship of \$500.00 is awarded to an upper-class undergraduate student with at least a 2.8 out of a 4.0 GPA or a graduate student with a GPA of 3.25 out of 4.0 or above. The student must be majoring in a field related to milk, food or environmental sanitation. The basis of the award should include good moral character, financial need and activities as well as academic performance.

The scholarship committee of the Department of Food Science and Nutrition at the University of Missouri-Columbia is responsible for obtaining applications from eligible students and shall screen the applications to find up to five of the most highly qualified. The awards committee of the Missouri Milk, Food, and Environmental Health Association shall select a recipient from the applicants sent them by the departmental committee and shall notify the chair of the committee of this action. The name of the awarded shall be forwarded to the University of Missouri Office of Student Aid by the chair of the departmental committee. The treasurer of MMFEHA shall send the check to the Office of Student Financial Aid, ATTN: Assistant Director for Scholarships, #11 Jesse Hall, University of Missouri, Columbia, MO 65211. The letter of transmittal shall indicate that the amount sent should be applied to the J. E. Edmondson Scholarship.

The Awards Committee chairman should make contact with the scholarship chair for the Department of Food Science and Nutrition no later than January 15th concerning the Joe Edmondson Scholarship. Nominations of potential candidates should be received by the Awards Committee by February 20 so that a decision may be made and notification returned to the scholarship chair by March 10th.
