Other awards which may be of interest to the membership include the Samuel J. Crumbine Consumer Protection Award, sponsored by the Food Service and Packaging Institute, Incorporated. This award is open to all local government environmental health departments which have a legal responsibility to protect the health of consumers in county, district, city, town, townships or like jurisdictions. State, institutional, industry and private programs are not eligible. Nominations are generally open from November 1st through the following March 30th. The National Environmental Health Association awards the Walter S. Mangold Award. Candidates are nominated through their local affiliates, and must be a member in good standing of NEHA, be actively engaged in environmental health and not be an incumbent of one of the national officers of NEHA.

The National Environmental Health Association further provides scholarship awards for study towards bachelor degrees in environmental health or post-graduate degrees in environmental health sciences and/or public health.
